The Career Intentions Survey is a major initiative of WLANSW for 2013. The survey seeks to obtain data with a view to tracking and analysing the career paths and decisions of both female and male law graduates in New South Wales.

The **Toplines Report** for the **Career Intentions Survey** pilot which took place in August to November last year will soon be available on the WLANSW website, together with the background information, on our Career Intentions Survey page under Workplace Practices http://www.womenlawyersnsw.org.au/content/career-intentions-survey-0

66 percent of student participants in the pilot propose to practise as a lawyer, while 7 percent do not propose to practise as a lawyer. Of those intending to practise as a lawyer, 57 percent propose to practise as a solicitor, 42 percent propose to practise as a government lawyer, 31 percent propose to practise as a barrister, and 28 percent propose to practise as an in house lawyer, as their long term ambition.

The top three areas of practice in which participants would like to specialise are corporate and commercial law (39 percent), criminal law (38 percent) and family law (23 percent).
